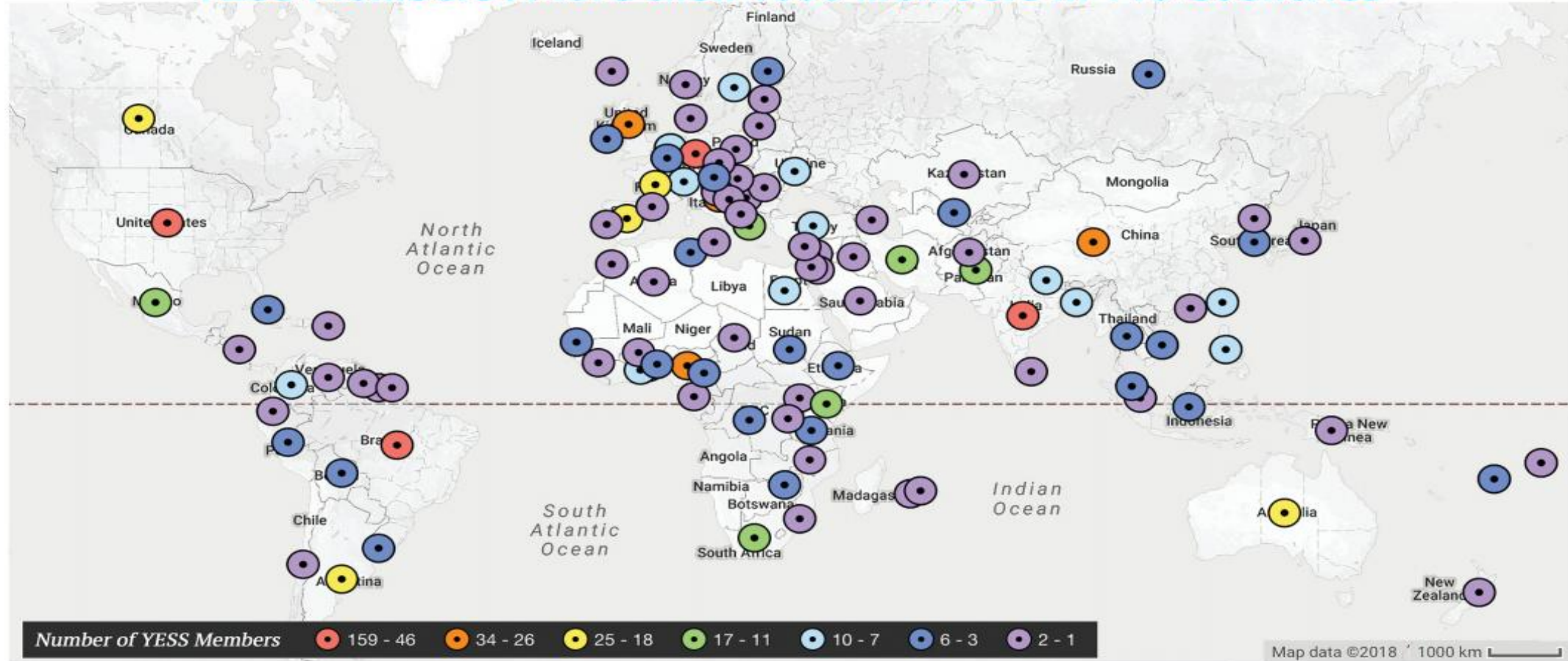

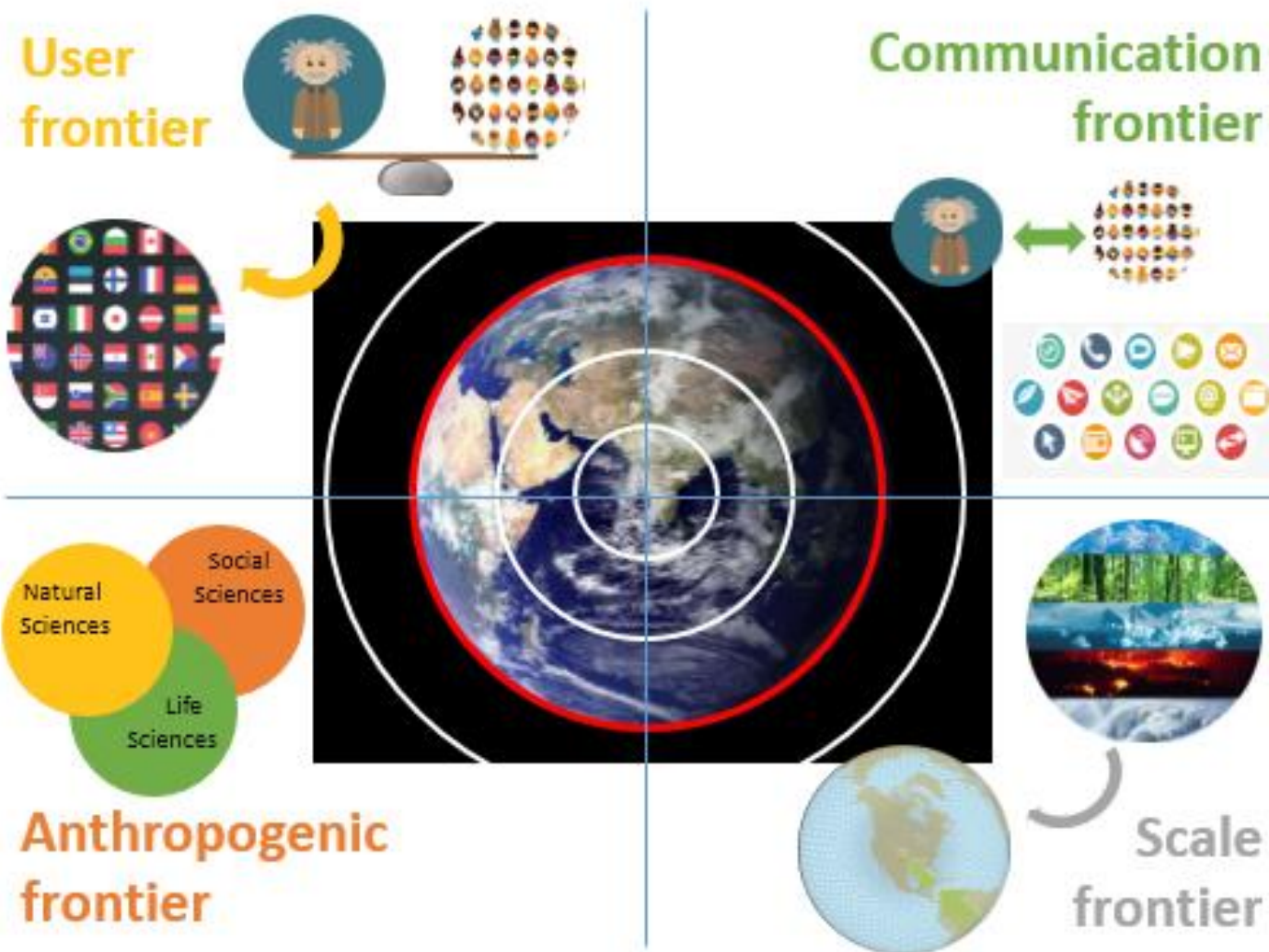
Structure
